The Bihar Revenue Service (Amendment) Rules, 2015

Notification

No. - 3/ Stha. (Niyamawali)-01/2015-

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(3)/Ra., Dated- 1 / 4 / 15

In the exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article, 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Bihar is pleased to make the following Rules to make amendments in the Bihar Revenue Service Rules, 2010 (As Amended from time to time) :-

1. Short title, extent and commencement.-(1) These Rules may be called the Bihar Revenue Service (Amendment) Rules, 2015,

(2) It shall extend to the whole of the State of Bihar.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment in Rule 2 (Ja), 4, 8, 8(a) (i), 8 (b) (i), 9 and Schedule-1 (a) (1) and (2) of the Bihar Revenue Service Rules, 2010 (As Amended).-The words "Anchal Nirikshak" designation used in Rule-2 (h), 4, 8, 8 (a) (i), 8 (b) (i), 9 and Schedule-1 (a) (1) and (2) in the said Rules will be substituted by the words "**Revenue Officer**".

3. Amendment in sub-rule (L) of Rule-2 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rule, 2010 (As Amended from time to time).-

Sub-rule (L) of Rule-2 of the said Rules shall be substituted by following:-

(L)"Commission" means the "Bihar Public Service Commission"

4. Amendment in Rule-3 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rules, 2010 (As Amended from time to time).- The following new sub-rule-(c) shall be added after sub rule (b) of the Rule-3 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rules, 2010 (As Amended) :-

" (c) This Service would be a gazetted service."

5. Amendment in the Rule-8 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rule, 2010 (As Amended from time to time).- Title of Rule-8 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rule, 2010 (As Amended from time to time) shall be substituted by following-

" 8. Appointment and promotion to the post of Revenue Officer and in its equivalent grade.-"

6. Sub rule "(B) of Rule-8 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rule, 2010 (As Amended from time to time) will be substituted by the following-

" (B) Promotion to the post of Revenue Officer and in its equivalent grade from Rajaswa Karamchari Cadre.-"

(i) 25 per cent of the posts of Revenue Officer and its equivalent would be filled on the basis of the recommendation of the Departmental Promotion Committee from the State-level gradation list of only graduate and its equivalent degree-holder Rajaswa Karamcharies.

Constitution of Departmental Promotion Committee will be made by the department.

(ii) Service of 10 years, confirmation of service and availability of confidential annual report of last 5 years would be essential for promotion on the basis of gradation-cum-eligibility.

(iii) Passing in the Departmental examinations to be determined by the Government from time to time for Rajaswa Karamcharies will be compulsory.

(iv) Reservation provisions determined by General Administration Department will be applied in promotion.

(v) Determination of state level seniority of Rajaswa Karamchari Cadre for promotion in Rajaswa Adhikari Cadre.- (a) There will be separate district-wise gradation list of Rajaswa Karamcharis.

A state level seniority list will be prepared from the final district-wise gradation list on the basis of date of joining in the district, in which, directions of the General Administration Department, Bihar, Patna will be followed :

Provided that, if the date of joining of any is same, gradation list will be prepared on the basis of date of birth, and if the date of birth too is same, gradation list will be prepared on the basis of lottery method and those having earlier date of birth will be treated senior to those having later date of birth.

(b) Seniority of the Rajaswa Karamcharies appointed on the recommendation of Bihar Staff Selection Commission will be according to the merit list recommended by the Commission.

(c) Seniority of the personnel appointed on the compassionate ground will be according to their dates of joining in the service and in that appointment year, they would be treated junior in the gradation list in the transaction.

7. Amendment in the Rule-15 of Chapter-3 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rules, 2010 (As Amended from time to time).-The proviso existing after the provisions of Rule-15 of Chapter-3 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rules, 2010 (As Amended from time to time) will be substituted as following-

"Provided that if the employee entering in this service as per the rule-3(a) has already passed the Departmental Examination, it will not be essential for him to pass the Departmental Examination again in the light of this Rule, but if such employee has not passed the Departmental Examination earlier after entering in this service, then passing Departmental Examination will be an essential condition for promotion for such employee."

8. Amendment in the Rule-15 of Chapter-3 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rules, 2010 (As Amended from time to time).- The following Rule 15A shall be added after Rule-15 of Chapter-3 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rules, 2010 (As Amended from time to time) :-

"15A Training. - (i) On entry, Induction Training will be compulsory after appointment in the basic post of Bihar Revenue Service.

(ii) It will be compulsory to obtain training, to be prescribed from time to time, for the officers of all grades in addition to the basic grade of the Bihar Revenue Service. Any one may get eligibility for promotion in the higher grade only after passing the examination, if any examination is held, after the training, but promotion will not be hindered due to non-holding of the training in time.

9. Amendment in the Rule-18 of the Bihar Service Rule-18 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rule, 2010 (As Amended from time to time).- The following proviso will be added after Rule-18 of the Bihar Revenue Service Rule, 2010 (As Amended from time to time):-

" Provided the services of the Executive Magistrates of this Service/Cadre for the posting/transfer, will be made available to the General Administration Department by the Revenue and Land Reforms Department. Service and Cadre control of those officers will remain under the Revenue and Land Reforms Department. General Administration Department will, at its level, delegate the powers of Executive Magistrates to the Executive Magistrates making transfer/posting in the earmarked sub-divisions for Revenue and Land Reforms Department under the relevant provisions of The Penal Procedure Code".


